

# Laguna Beach Recycles!

## RECYCLING GREEN WASTE



Residents with curbside service can request an additional green waste cart at no additional charge. Three different sized wheeled carts are available - 35 gallons, 64 gallons, or 96 gallons. Simply call Waste Management to schedule a delivery of additional carts. Only carts provided by Waste Management will be serviced. Remember to place green waste directly into the green waste cart. If you occasionally generate extra green waste, you can place up to five non-black bags of green waste next to the green waste cart (bags must be 35 gallon size or smaller and weigh less than 50 pounds). You can call for a bulky item pick up for as many as 20 bags. This is a special service and must be scheduled in advance by calling Waste Management. Residents with curbside service get two bulky item pick-ups per year at no charge.

## FREE RECYCLING OF BATTERIES, TUBES & FLUORESCENT LAMPS

The City of Laguna Beach offers free recycling of these items to residents. Look for the **MDS recycling kiosks** at the following locations:

## WHAT GOES IN YOUR CARTS?



## COMMINGLED RECYCLING

Items that can be placed in the recycling cart with the "gray" lid.

### Plastics

- Plastic beverage containers - soda, water, juice
- Plastic containers (#1-7) such as laundry detergent, ketchup, hair product bottles
- Plastic bags - grocery, dry cleaning, news paper and other film bags (bundle inside a plastic bag, tie and place in the cart)
- Plastic buckets (#1-#7)
- Plastic tubs (#1-#7)
- Plastic toys (#1-7)



Look for the "chasing arrow" symbol to identify if a plastic item can be recycled. Also known as a "resin" code, this symbol is often found on the bottom of plastic containers and tells you what plastic was used to make the item.

### Metal

- Aluminum cans
- Tin cans - soup, tuna, vegetable juice
- Empty aerosol cans (must be empty)
- Pie tins
- Paint cans (empty, completely dried out)
- Hangers

### Paper / Cardboard

- Newspapers, magazines
- Mixed paper (all types accepted)
- Telephone books, directories, magazines
- Bulk/junk mail, envelopes, catalogs
- Cardboard boxes (please flatten)
- Soft-bound books, hard-bound books (inside only, no cover)
- Paper board - cereal boxes, tissue boxes, shoe boxes, egg cartons, beverage boxes
- Frozen dinner boxes and other frozen food boxes
- Empty paper towel and toilet tissue rolls
- Shredded paper (bag before placing in cart)
- Pizza boxes (no food residue)
- Paper towels (must be clean and dry)

### Glass

- Food jars - sauce, mayo, pickles (no residue)
- Beverage glass bottles - wine, beer, liquor, juice

### Plastic Bag Recycling

Residents with curbside recycling service may now place plastic bags in the recycling cart. Please place plastic bags for recycling inside a plastic bag, not loose in the cart to ensure that all the plastic will be caught in the sorting process.

## TRASH

Items that are not acceptable in the recycling program should be placed in the trash cart with the "blue" lid.

- Food waste
- Pet waste, items soiled by pet waste
- Disposable diapers
- Styrofoam (packing peanuts, cups, egg trays, meat trays)
- Plastics with no numbers (missing #1-7)
- Light bulbs (incandescent)
- Drinking glasses, glass dishware
- Mirrors, window or windshield glass
- Rubber / latex items
- Palm fronds, bird of paradise and other succulent/fibrous plants

## GREEN WASTE RECYCLING

Green waste items can be placed in the cart with the "green" lid.

- Grass clippings
- Leaves
- Yard and garden prunings
- Small tree branches
- Shrubs
- Small pieces of wood, sawdust
