

DISTRICTS OF LAGUNA BEACH

GALLERY ROW DISTRICT Offering a wide selection of art galleries and antique shops, the Gallery Row District also boasts a variety of casual dining and ethnic cuisine. The Laguna Art Museum and Heisler Park are a short walking distance of downtown Laguna Beach.

DOWNTOWN VILLAGE The Downtown Village includes an array of award winning restaurants, boutiques, shops and art galleries. Convenient public parking is located nearby.

CANYON ARTS DISTRICT Set amid 20,000 acres of wilderness, the Canyon Arts District is filled with well-known galleries, art festivals, artists' studios, unique eateries and a wine tasting venue.

HIP DISTRICT The HIP District (Historic and Interesting Places) is home to Laguna's oldest architecture; including La Casa del Camino, The Old Pottery Place and The English Garden, as well as galleries, shops, boutiques, restaurants, and the historic Brooks Street, home of the Brooks St. Surfing Classic. Located between Legion Street and Cleo Street, **SLEEPY HOLLOW** is home of the first juice bar in California and the center of the Orange County hippie movement. Sleepy Hollow offers an array of eclectic shops, restaurants and art galleries in the spirit of its funky history.

PEARL STREET DISTRICT With top-rated restaurants and cuisine from around the world, the Pearl Street District also offers vintage stores, galleries, shops, boutiques, and consignment shops.

SOUTH LAGUNA South Laguna boasts a collection of exceptional art galleries, award winning restaurants, breathtaking views, and chic shops. It is also home to Treasure Island Park and The Montage Resort.
