

Transfers . . . are free

Free transfer to a connecting Laguna route can be obtained when boarding the bus at your original departure location.

OCTA all day pass can only be accepted for a transfer by Laguna Beach Transit at OCTA bus stops: Laguna Canyon, North Coast Highway, South Coast Highway and Depot.

When you ride

- As the bus approaches, signal to let the driver know you want to board.
- Please have exact fare to ride, drivers do not give change!
- No smoking, drinking, eating or playing of radios is allowed.
- To avoid being carried past your stop, signal the driver in advance.
- Please remove children from strollers, and fold strollers.
- Please give front seats to elderly & disabled persons as they board bus.
- Only service animals are allowed on the bus. All other pets must be secured in a pet carrier to board.

- Cuando el autobus se aproxima, hágale señales al chofer para que sepa que quiere abordarlo.
- Ud. debe tener cambio exacto para viajar, los choferes no llevan cambio.
- No se permite fumar, comer o el uso de radios.
- Avise al chofer con anticipación para evitar que se pase.
- Lo sentimos pero, no se permiten animales domésticos en el autobus (excepto perros guías).
- Por favor ceda los asientos delanteros a personas mayores o incapacitadas a medida que abordan el autobus.

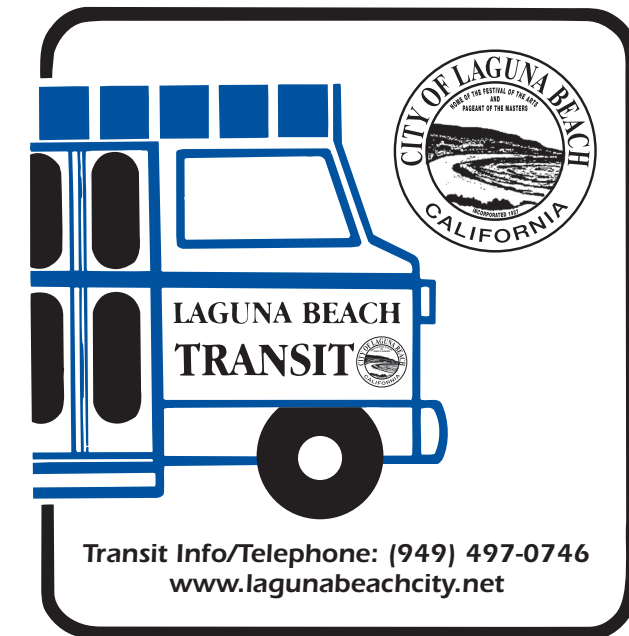
- Advance Request (one to fourteen day advance request)
