RECREATION COMMITTEE SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM POLICY

The Recreation Committee Scholarship program is a financial assistance program designed to assist in providing recreational opportunities to families through the City of Laguna Beach Community Assistance Grant Program. Scholarship recipients must be receiving some type of public assistance to be considered for eligibility. All requests and approvals for program assistance will be determined by the Recreation Committee.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

Families must live within the Laguna Beach Unified School District boundaries, and participate in National School Lunch Program (NSLP) qualifying for free or reduced meals or identified with a different social service agency.

HOW TO APPLY:

Complete the attached application and bring it to Community Services office during regular business hours, Monday through Thursday 7:30 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. or Friday's 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.:

PROGRAM GUIDELINES:

- Households are eligible to receive up to \$200 per scholarship year while funds last. The scholarship year will begin **July 1** and end on **June 30** each year.
- Households may only receive the amount of funds needed for registration for a specific class or program, up to \$100 per participant. Approved funds must be used toward the program or class at the time of approval. If the class or program fee is more than approved assistance, you will be required to pay the balance at the time of registration.
- In the event that the registrant misses more than half of the class or program for which scholarship dollars were awarded OR does not attend any of the classes in which you received scholarship funds, you will be ineligible for scholarship funds for the next calendar year.
- When turning in your application, you must submit all required documentation for proof of financial need and an original proof of residency.
- If approved, the City of Laguna Beach program registration form and waiver must also be completed. The participant must be able to meet all program eligibility requirements.
- Materials and/or uniform fees are paid for by grant recipient (when applicable).
- The Recreation Committee sets the guidelines for the program.
- Private instruction lessons and tournament fees are not included in this program.
- Participant may be referred to another qualifying scholarship program, if applicable.
