

# **Alternative Sleeping Location**

## **Opening November 12**

**1900 Laguna Canyon Road**



**The alternative sleeping location will be open every day at 1900 Laguna Canyon Road (the ACT V lot) starting Thursday, November 12, and will provide:**

- **Caring staff and volunteers**
- **A heated building with mats for sleeping**
- **Blankets, water and food**
- **Duffle bags for storage (limited to one duffle bag per person)**
- **Free bus ride to and from the facility (see details below)**

**To use the sleeping facility you must arrive no earlier than 6 p.m. and no later than 8 p.m.**

**To use the City bus you must be at the bus depot by 6:10 p.m. Late arrivals will not be able to ride the bus. To ride the bus in the morning, you must be ready to leave ACT V by 6:10 a.m. Those who do not ride the bus may stay until 7:30 a.m.**

**The morning bus runs Monday-Friday, and the evening bus runs Monday-Saturday.**

**ONCE THE ALTERNATIVE SLEEPING FACILITY IS OPEN FOR USE, OVERNIGHT SLEEPING, CAMPING AND LODGING WILL NOT BE PERMITTED ON BEACHES, PARKS OR OTHER PUBLIC PROPERTIES.**

## **ALTERNATIVE SLEEPING LOCATION RULES**

**Our rules are for the safety and security of all who use the facility.**

**Thank you for agreeing to the following:**

- **Please use appropriate conduct at all times, including while riding the bus. Disruptive behavior will not be tolerated.**
- **You must arrive between 6 p.m. and 8 p.m. and leave by 7:30 a.m. If you leave the facility between 8 p.m. and 6 a.m., you may not return.**
- **Your belongings must fit in the large duffle bag we provide or must fit on your sleeping mat.**
- **Please provide photo ID or other identification. If you do not have a photo ID, we will help you obtain one.**
- **No animals are allowed at the facility, except service animals with proper documentation.**
- **Smoking is permitted only in designated areas.**
- **Illegal drugs and alcohol are not permitted.**
- **No weapons are allowed at the facility. Firearms will be confiscated. Knives will be held safely and returned upon exit.**

## **CITY BUS RULES**

- **The bus ride is free at 6:10 p.m. from the depot and the Act V lot and the 6:10 a.m. bus ride from the ACT V lot and the depot. The use of the buses at all other times requires payment of a 75¢ fare**
- **No animals are allowed on the bus except service animals with proper documentation**
- **Wheel chairs not being used by a disabled person for their personal transportation and used to carry belongings are considered carts and not allowed on the bus at any time**
- **No eating or drinking is allowed**
- **Radios must be silent**
