**Double Fee.** When work for which a permit is required by these regulations is started or proceeded with prior to obtaining the permit, the fees above specified shall be doubled, but the payment of such double fee shall not relieve any persons from fully complying with the requirements of any applicable code in the execution of the work nor from any other penalties prescribed.

**Exception.** The payment of double fees shall not apply to emergency work when it shall be proved to the satisfaction of the City Engineer that such work was urgently necessary and that it was not practical to obtain a permit therefore before the commencement of the work. In all such cases, a permit must be obtained as soon as it is practical to so do, and if there be an unreasonable delay in obtaining such permit, a double fee as herein provided shall be charged.

## **CONSUMER PRICE INDEX ADJUSTMENT**
